Summary of Opportunity:	PFG Group Ltd, trading as Daily Fresh, invites suitably qualified and experienced contractors to submit a competitive tender for the design, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of a solar photovoltaic energy system at its operational site on Trentham Road, Newstead Industrial Estate, Stoke-on-Trent, ST4 8HX. The purpose of the project is to reduce the business's reliance on grid-supplied electricity, improve energy efficiency, lower long-term operating costs and reduce the carbon impact associated with its food-processing, refrigeration, storage and distribution operations. The successful contractor will be expected to assess the site and propose an appropriately sized, technically compliant and commercially viable system based on the site's electricity-consumption profile and available installation area. The tender should cover all required solar panels, inverters, mounting systems, cabling, electrical protection, monitoring equipment, access arrangements, installation works and commissioning. The contractor should also identify and support any structural assessments, landlord requirements, planning considerations, Distribution Network Operator applications or electrical infrastructure works required for successful delivery. Tender submissions should clearly state the proposed system capacity, estimated annual generation, expected self-consumption, projected financial and carbon savings, warranties, delivery programme, maintenance arrangements and full itemised cost.

	the design, supply, installation, testing, commissioning and handover of a complete solar photovoltaic system at: Daily Fresh, Trentham Road, Newstead Industrial Estate, Stoke-on-Trent, ST4 8HX <u>What to Include in your Quotation Submission:</u> The appointed contractor will be required to: • Complete all necessary site, roof, structural and electrical assessments. • Review the site's historical electricity consumption and operational energy profile. • Recommend an appropriately sized solar PV system that maximises on-site use of the electricity generated. • Provide the proposed system capacity in kWp and an estimated annual generation forecast in kWh. • Supply all solar panels, inverters, mounting systems, cabling, meters, isolators, electrical protection and monitoring equipment. • Include all labour, access equipment, scaffolding and associated installation works. • Identify and manage any planning, landlord, Distribution Network Operator or grid-connection requirements applicable to the proposed system. • Integrate the system safely with the site's existing electrical infrastructure. • Complete testing, commissioning, certification and handover. • Provide remote monitoring access and appropriate training for nominated employees. • Supply complete technical documentation, warranties, operating manuals and maintenance requirements. Tender submissions must include a detailed technical proposal, itemised pricing, estimated annual energy generation, projected financial and carbon savings, proposed delivery programme, equipment specifications, warranty periods, maintenance arrangements, relevant accreditations and examples of comparable commercial installations. The system must be designed and installed in accordance with all applicable technical, electrical, health and safety, building and grid-connection requirements. Contractors should clearly identify any assumptions, exclusions, dependencies or additional works within their submission.
